



## Where did Joshua get that type of faith?

**Exodus 33:11 (NIV)** <sup>11</sup> The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent.

I don't serve Jesus because a sun stood still on a day for Joshua . . .  
I serve Jesus because a sun stood still for me.

## So, what do you do when the sun goes down?

**Joshua 10:9-14 (NIV)** <sup>9</sup> After an all-night march from Gilgal, Joshua took them by surprise. <sup>10</sup> The LORD threw them into confusion before Israel, so Joshua and the Israelites defeated them completely at Gibeon. Israel pursued them along the road going up to Beth Horon and cut them down all the way to Azekah and Makkedah. <sup>11</sup> As they fled before Israel on the road down from Beth Horon to Azekah, the LORD hurled large hailstones down on them, and more of them died from the hail than were killed by the swords of the Israelites.

<sup>12</sup> On the day the LORD gave the Amorites over to Israel, Joshua said to the LORD in the presence of Israel:  
"Sun, stand still over Gibeon,  
and you, moon, over the Valley of Aijalon."

- When the sun goes down, don't lose yourself.
- When the sun goes down, find some un-natural light:

**Psalms 119:105 (KJV)** <sup>105</sup> Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

## When the sun goes down, don't forget what happened during the daylight

**Joshua 10:11 (NIV)** <sup>11</sup> As they fled before Israel on the road down from Beth Horon to Azekah, the LORD hurled large hailstones down on them, and more of them died from the hail than were killed by the swords of the Israelites.

When the sun goes down it's easy to forget that God is **STILL** Great and is **STILL** Good:
