## I. INTRO

A. The Dash

John 14:1-3 (NLT) "Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. <sup>2</sup> There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? <sup>3</sup> When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.

John 14:4-5 (NLT) <sup>4</sup> And you know the way to where I am going." <sup>5</sup> "No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?"

B. This question – How can we know the way – is one that humanity is asking

John 14:6 (NLT) Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

• The way isn't some obscure path or a church or religion – it's a person named Jesus

## II. JESUS IS THE WAY

A. I am the way so... follow me

Matthew 9:9 (New King James Version) As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me So he arose and followed Him.

- Jesus made a simple offer follow me
