Big Idea:

EYES OPEN, HEARTS AFIRE

Big Idea: On the road to Emmaus

After the crucifixion, two of Jesus' followers encountered Him while on a journey but didn't recognize Him at first. When their eyes were opened, they realized it was Jesus and said, 'Didn't our hearts burn within us as He explained the Scriptures?' Within the hour, they returned to Jerusalem. Tonight, we pray for our eyes to be open and hearts on fire!

Luke 24:13-35 (NIV)

Psalm 39:3 (NIV) My heart grew hot within me. While I meditated, the fire burned; then I spoke with my tongue.

Jeremiah 20:9 (NIV) But if I say, "I will not mention his word or speak anymore in his name," his word is in my heart like a fire, a fire shut up in my bones. I am weary of holding it in; indeed, I cannot.

Ephesians 6:19 (TLB) Pray for me, too, and ask God to give me the right words as I boldly tell others about the Lord and as I explain to them that his salvation is for the Gentiles too.

☐ Pray that eyes will be opened and hearts set on fire
☐ Pray that God's people will be bold as a lion
☐ Pray for people you know to be awakened to God, their eyes opened and discover a freshness with God
☐ Ask God to give us a heart for those that are lost and far from Him

Big Idea:

- John 16:24 (TPT) Until now you've not been bold enough to ask the Father for a single thing in my name, but now you can ask, and keep on asking him! And you can be sure that you'll receive what you ask for, and your joy will have no limits!
- Matthew 5:14, 16 (NKJV) "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NLT) Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you?
