- IV. Galatians 5:1 (NIV) <sup>1</sup> It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.
  - A. If living in/with freedom was easy, why would we be told to stand firm?

Galatians 5:13 (NIV) <sup>13</sup> You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

B. Don't misuse your freedom

Galatians 5:14-15 (NIV) <sup>14</sup> "... Love your neighbor as yourself." <sup>15</sup> If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.
