II. Who is this GOOD SHEPHERD that is sitting at the head of the table, wanting to be the one thing we stay focused on?

- A. The entire story of the history of man is that *this being* is trying to restore us to himself
- B. The story has started...we are in the middle of the story
- C. So let's find out what HE calls HIMSELF
 - 1. YHWH – YAHWEH – JEHOVA translated in English bibles – “LORD”
 - Distinguished between Adonai, which indicates “Lord.”

Exodus 3:13-14 (NJKV) ¹³ Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, *when* I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they say to me, ‘What *is* His name?’ what shall I say to them?” ¹⁴ And God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘I AM has sent me to you.’ ”

- 2. EL ELYON – The most high, or the very highest God
 - Absolute right to lordship.

Deuteronomy 26:19 (NKJV) and that He will set you high above all nations which He has made, in praise, in name, and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the Lord your God, just as He has spoken.”

- 3. JEHOVA ELOHIM – Lord God
 - Combination of YHWH and generic Lord, signifying is He is LORD of Lords

Genesis 2:4 (NKJV) This *is* the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens,

- 4. JEHOVA ROHI – The Lord is my shepherd (Psalm 23)
- 5. JEHOVA JIREH – The Lord will provide

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Genesis 22:13-14 (NKJV) ¹³ Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind *him* was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. ¹⁴ And Abraham called the name of the place, The-Lord-Will-Provide; as it is said to this day, “In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided.”

6. JEHOVA RAPHA – I Am the Lord who heals you (Exodus 15:27)
 - Preserving; curing; delivering – Spirit, soul and body.
7. JEHOVA NISSI – The Lord is our banner
 - Signifies a rallying place.
8. JEHOVA M'KADDESH – The Lord who sanctifies and makes holy
 - God makes it clear that HE alone, not the law, can cleanse his people and make them holy.
9. JEHOVA SHALOM – The Lord is peace
 - First revealed to Gideon after he knew he had seen the Lord in person face to face.
10. JEHOVA TSIDKENU – The Lord is my righteousness

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV) For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

- A. There is nothing that you did, or can do, that can make you righteous
 - B. Now because you have been made righteous there are things you do and don't do
11. JEHOVA SHAMMA – the Lord is there
 - In the old covenant there is an indicator that the Glory of the Lord, which departed in Ezekiel 8, had returned in Ezekiel 44.
- A. We have a better covenant based on better promises!

Hebrews 13:5 (NKJV) *Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.”*

12. JEHOVA SABAOOTH – Lord of Hosts (hordes): angels, men, heaven, earth, Jews, Gentiles, rich, poor, master, slave...
 - He will accomplish, what HE determines to do...take that to the bank.
