

II. WE NEED SYSTEMS IN PLACE

 - God and His word are the final authority and the absolute standard of truth

Genesis 2:18 (NKJV) And the Lord God said, "*It is* not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

• God knew it wasn't good for Adam to be alone, but Adam needed to know it wasn't good for him to be alone as well

Genesis 2:21-25 (NKJV) ²¹ And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. ²² Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. ²³ And Adam said: "This *is* now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."

A. God wants to help you build your home



• System of learning skills that prepare for life

2 Thessalonians 3:10 (NKJV) For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.

- Teach an attitude along with work
- Chores teach how to handle money

Proverbs 22:7 (MSG) The poor are always ruled over by the rich, so don't borrow and put yourself under their power.
