 - o Irritability and anger

 - Lack of motivation or interest in things
 - Anxiety, nervousness or worry
 - Headaches
 - Feeling sad or depressed
 - o Indigestion, acid reflux or upset stomach
 - Muscle tension
 - Appetite changes
