I. INTRO/REVIEW

- A. Here
 - Dictionary.com: In this place; in this spot or locality (opposed to there)
- B. "HERE" is the best place you can be, because "HERE" is where God is
 - Sound bites from the last few weeks...
 - o The desire to be "THERE" becomes the enemy of "HERE"
