Proverbs 31:1 (NLT) The sayings of King Lemuel contain this message, which his mother taught him.

- B. Momma said part 1

- C. We unintentionally learned things, what if we were intentional?

Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV) Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.

Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord."

Matthew 6:33 (NIRV) But put God's kingdom first. Do what he wants you to do. Then all those things will also be given to you.

1 Timothy 3:4-5 (NKJV) one who rules his own house well, having *his* children in submission with all reverence (for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?);

### IV. THE STANDARD AND THE EXAMPLE

- A. God has set the standard and given us an example
  - The kingdom of God teaches us to submit our opinion to the standard of the kingdom

Where the purpose of a thing is not known, abuse is inevitable. - Dr. Myles Monroe

- B. Without understanding the purpose, abuse is inevitable
- C. You are a steward, a ruler, a standard of your children

Genesis 22:2 (NLT) "Take your son, your only son—yes, Isaac, whom you love so much—and go to the land of Moriah. Go and sacrifice him as a burnt offering on one of the mountains, which I will show you."

- D. Abraham was asked to sacrifice Isaac the child of promise on an altar
  - Prepare them to leave

Genesis 22:13-14 (NLT) Then Abraham looked up and saw a ram caught by its horns in a thicket. So, he took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering in place of his son. Abraham named the place Yahweh-Yireh (which means "the Lord will provide"). To this day, people still use that name as a proverb: "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided."
