I. FOLLOW ME

- A. Jesus shows us 3 things in John 12
 - Jesus shows us who He is
 - Jesus is the King of Israel

John 12:20-21 (TLB) Some Greeks who had come to Jerusalem to attend the Passover paid a visit to Philip, who was from Bethsaida, and said, "Sir, we want to meet Jesus."

B. Jesus shows us what he is going to do

John 12:23-24 (TLB) Jesus replied that the time had come for him to return to his glory in heaven, and that "I must fall and die like a kernel of wheat that falls into the furrows of the earth. Unless I die I will be alone—a single seed. But my death will produce many new wheat kernels—a plentiful harvest of new lives.

• If I let you crown me king, I'll be like a singular seed

John 12:26 (TLB) "If these Greeks want to be my disciples, tell them to come and follow me, for my servants must be where I am. And if they follow me, the Father will honor them.

- C. God isn't satisfied with one. He wants many
 - Jesus isn't just king for Israel, but to the whole world

John 3:16-17 (NLT) "For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.

Hebrews 2:11 (NIRV) And Jesus, who makes people holy and the people he makes holy belong to the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them his brothers and sisters.

Romans 8:29 (TLB) For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son, so that his Son would be the First, with many brothers.

II. TRUE LIFE STARTS WITH A DEATH

A. Jesus shows us what it will mean

John 12:25 (TLB) If you love your life down here—you will lose it. If you despise your life down here—you will exchange it for eternal glory.

• The most important decision you will make is, "What will I do with this life?"

John 15:8 (NIV) This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.
