Luke 18:8 (NKJV) I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"

- C. What is faith?
  - We should probably know what faith is if that's what Jesus is looking for

Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Faith has a source

Romans 10:17 (NKJV) So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Faith has a father – Abraham

Hebrews 11:8 (TLB) Abraham trusted God, and when God told him to leave home and go far away to another land that he promised to give him, Abraham obeyed. Away he went, not even knowing where he was going.

# **II. THE PROCESS**

- A. Faith carries a risk
  - Faith is going to ask you to leave something behind for something that's ahead
- B. Leave, go, show, make and bless

Genesis 12:1-3 (NLT) The Lord had said to Abram, "<u>Leave</u> your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and <u>go</u> to the land that <u>I will show you</u>. <u>I will make you into</u> a great nation. <u>I will bless you</u> and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt. All the families on earth will be blessed through you."

- The expression of faith isn't clarity, but obedience
- C. The hardest thing to "leave" and "let go" of
  - Trying to have both faith AND control will leave you frustrated

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIRV) Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Do not depend on your own understanding. In all your ways obey him. Then he will make your paths smooth and straight.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT) Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

- B. Why over what

  - Can you believe that your life is getting better and better from this day forward?
