



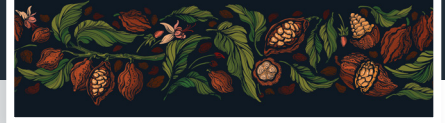

A. Father of our faith - Abraham

Genesis 12:1 (NLT) The Lord had said to Abram, “Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father’s family, and go to the land that I will show you.

- The expression of faith isn’t always clarity
- The expression of faith is trust

B. How can I see what isn’t visible?

Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

- **Sight is what I see with my eyes open, imagination is what I see with my eyes closed**

C. The value of a vision

Genesis 15:1 (NLT) Some time later, the Lord spoke to Abram in a vision and said to him, “Do not be afraid, Abram, for I will protect you, and your reward will be great.”

Genesis 15:5-6 (NLT) Then the Lord took Abram outside and said to him, “Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That’s how many descendants you will have!” And Abram believed the Lord, and the Lord counted him as righteous because of his faith.

D. God’s ultimate plan for Abram was bigger than Abram

Genesis 12:2-3 (NLT) I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt. All the families on earth will be blessed through you.”

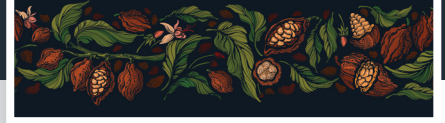
