



Key Scripture:

Isaiah 50:4 (NKJV)

“The Lord GOD has given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary. He awakens me morning by morning, He awakens my ear to hear as the learned.”

Introduction:

- A word in season is a fresh Word from the Lord
- We need direction daily, which comes by hearing from our heavenly Father
- **Lamentations 3:22-24** reminds us: His mercies and His Word are new every morning

I. Morning by Morning: The Daily Need for God's Perspective

- A. Life happens daily—morning by morning
- B. Perspective is everything; it's time to get GOD'S perspective for the day ahead
 - *Fun Quote #1* : Stressed spelled backward is desserts!
- C. Get into a God RUT: good habits are hard to break too!
 - Start by giving God permission to awaken you each day
 - Declare: *“Father, I thank you that I have ears to hear!”* (John 10:27)
- D. You are not meant to live by natural things alone
 - **Matthew 4:4**: *“Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.”*

II. A Word for Your Season

- A. God has a specific Word for you in the season you are in
 - Whether it's a season of new beginnings:
 - New career, new baby, new home, new city, newlyweds, or new finances
 - Or a season you wouldn't choose:
 - Empty nester, widowhood, unemployment, physical battles, or feeling abandoned
 - **Ecclesiastes 3:1**: *“To everything there is a season...”*
- B. Hold onto God's promises during difficult seasons:
 - **Psalm 91:2**: *“I will say of the Lord, ‘He is my refuge and my fortress.’”*
 - **Proverbs 18:10**: *“The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.”*
- C. Let God's Word carry you through the season:
 - Get that FRESH WORD from God and hold onto it like a bulldog!
 - Don't let circumstances dictate your joy



III. Your Growth Impacts Others

- A. Personal growth in the Lord is never just for you
 - God's work in your life is meant to bless others
 - *Story*: "Looking for the One."
- B. Even your small acts can make a big impact
 - *FQ#2*: "If you think you are too small to be effective, you've never been with a mosquito in the dark."
- C. Believe this truth:
 - You won't have words for others unless you hear His voice
 - Declare: "*That I should know how to speak!*"
 - **John 10:27**: The Holy Spirit will give you the words to say

IV. The Move of God: Person to Person

- A. The move of God happens through individual encounters
 - "*God, use me today to show YOU to someone else.*"
- B. When His Word becomes your Word, transformation happens:
 - Every circumstance, devil, and situation must align with God's Word

V. The New Covenant

- A. **Hebrews 8 (The Message)**:
 - This new plan isn't written on paper or chiseled in stone
 - It's written in our hearts
 - God declares: "*I'll be their God, and they'll be my people... I'll kindly forgive them, and their sins will be wiped clean.*"
- B. Engage in your covenant relationship with Father God

Conclusion:

- Seek a fresh Word for the season you are in
- Let it sustain and transform you, while blessing others through your life
- God's Word is alive and active—live it out every day!
