



I. INTRO

A. The best day to be alive!

Ephesians 3:3–5 (TPT) For this wonderful mystery, which I briefly described, was given to me by divine revelation, so that whenever you read it you will be able to understand my revelation and insight into the secret mystery of the Messiah. There has never been a generation that has been given the detailed understanding of this glorious and divine mystery until now. He kept it a secret until this generation. God is revealing it only now to his sacred apostles and prophets by the Holy Spirit.

B. Paul's mystery

Ephesians 3:6 (TPT) Here's the secret: The gospel of grace has made you, non-Jewish believers, into co-heirs of his promise through your union with Jesus the Messiah. You are now members of his body—one with the Anointed One!

- Paul's revelation laid the foundation for the Church to live in the power of the risen Christ, and advance His Kingdom

C. God is building something that is continually growing

Ephesians 2:20-22 (TPT) *You are rising like the perfectly fitted stones of the temple;* and your lives have been built up together upon the foundation laid by the apostles and prophets, and best of all, you are connected to the Head Cornerstone of the building, the Anointed One, Jesus Christ himself! This entire building is under construction and is continually growing under his supervision until it rises up completed as the holy temple of the Lord himself. This means that God is transforming each one of you (transformation series, from grace to grace and glory to glory from rev to manifestation, transformed into the image you see in the mirror – which truth or reflection are you going to believe? – *quit waiting to become and realize that you are – children, heirs, one, righteous, blessed, free, healed*) **into the Holy of Holies, his dwelling place**, (From Moses tabernacle, to Solomon's temple the Holy of Holies is where the presence of God would reside. Presence, power, favor or grace, now 1 Cor 6 – you are the temple, but God's idea is so much bigger, 1 Cor 3: Together we are the temple of God) **through the power of the Holy Spirit living in you!**

II. FROM RATTLING BONES TO A BATTLE CRY

A. From dry bones to battle cry

- The miracle didn't happen until Ezekiel spoke the Words of God
- God's Word + God's Spirit = Dead things coming to life

Ezekiel 37:10 (NIV) So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army.

B. The Kingdom of God is where resurrection and transformation happens

- Sometimes the places in our lives feel dried up, forgotten, or impossible. But when God speaks life & the **spirit breathes**, what was long dead comes alive



Ezekiel 37:13-14a (NIV) Then you, my people, will know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. I will put my Spirit in you and you will live...

C. Beyond enough

- This is one of the most powerful, Spirit-filled prayers in all of Scripture:

Ephesians 3:16-17 (TPT) And I pray that he would unveil within you the unlimited riches of his glory and favor until supernatural strength floods your innermost being with his divine might and explosive power. Then, by constantly using your faith, the life of Christ will be released deep inside you, and the resting place of his love will become the very source and root of your life.

- Faith isn't a one-time decision, it's a lifestyle
- Faith is how we partner with what God has already done in us
- God's love anchors our faith, not performance, or perfection

D. He will outdo them all

Ephesians 3:20 (TPT) Never doubt God's mighty power to work in you and accomplish all this. He will achieve infinitely more than your greatest request, your most unbelievable dream, and exceed your wildest imagination! He will outdo them all, for his miraculous power constantly energizes you.
