B. What's the meaning of life?

- This question is the recognition that there's more, something is missing

**Ephesians 3:20a (NIV) Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine...**

- There is nothing too hard for our God

## II. THE GOD OF MORE

A. The God of eternity

- When we talk about "more," we have to start with who God is

**Isaiah 57:15 (NKJV) For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy *place*, With him *who* has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones.**

- God isn't trapped in our timeline

**Isaiah 57:15b (MSG) A Message from the high and towering God, who lives in Eternity, whose name is Holy: "I live in the high and holy places but also with the low-spirited, the spirit-crushed**

B. The power of the Holy Spirit is what takes a dead spirit and makes it alive

**Isaiah 57:15 (MSG) A Message from the high and towering God, who lives in Eternity, whose name is Holy: but also with the low-spirited, the spirit-crushed. And what I do is put new spirit in them, get them up and on their feet again. (Ruach – wind breath blast of air)**

**Philippians 1:6 (NIRV) God began a good work in you. And I am sure that he will carry it on until it is completed. That will be on the day Christ Jesus returns.**

## III. STANDING ON THE PROMISES OF GOD

A. For every promise there's a process

- We love promises, but not "obedience, character, humility, endurance"
- Every promise carries a process inside it
- **The promise isn't separate from the process, the process is the delivery system of the promise**

**John 15:1-2 (NKJV) "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.**



B. There is more, but the more is in you

**Ephesians 3:20 (NIV) Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us**

- Because the “more” you’re praying for is often on the other side of the “more” God is building *in you*

**Philemon 1:6 (NKJV) that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.**

C. If you want “more” you’re going to have to make a “move”

**Psalm 37:23 (TPT) The steps of the God-pursuing ones follow firmly in the footsteps of the Lord, and God delights in every step they take to follow him.**

D. What’s your next move?

- A move toward God

- A move toward mission
